

Turtle Geometry

We're pretty sure there were no pizza-obsessed turtles in the Cloaca Maxima, the early Roman sewers (which are still in use today!), but this turtle is stuck above ground. If you can find a thematically appropriate (and similarly ancient) entrance, you might be able to figure out how close the turtle's home is.



This is a location puzzle. You may not be able to solve this without finding the appropriate location. You can find what you need near Dig Site BETA.
